



# Call for Nominations 2017 Student/Resident/Administrative Fellow Board Observer

The ACHE – SETC Board of Directors are pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for an available seat for a qualified health administration graduate student and one Resident or administrative Fellow to serve as observers on the Chapter's Board in 2017 for a total of six meetings.

The intent of this program is to provide an opportunity for a student, Resident or Fellow to observe the interworking of board volunteers comprised of seasoned professionals who serve at various levels within their respective healthcare organizations as well as role models in their leadership capacity. Successful Observer applicants receive a chance to further enhance their career-development by attending six board meetings during the course of the year listening and learning as they interface with mid to senior careerists.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

#### A. Student Qualifications:

- 1. Currently enrolled in a CAHME or AASCB accredited health administration program(HA) which is also a member of the ACHE's Higher Education Network (HEN)
- 2. Will not graduate from HA program during the period of the appointment
- 3. Student Associate of ACHE national organization in good standing
- 4. Recommend by the Director of their HA program
- 5. 250 word essay by answering the following question: "Why is this appointment, as a Board Observer, important for you and what value does it contribute to your relationship with ACHE as a component of your career development?"

#### B. Resident or Fellow Qualifications:

- 1. Will be serving as a Resident or Fellow in 2017 and is from a CAHME or AASCB Accredited HA program which is also a member of the ACHE's Higher Education Network (HEN)
- 2. Recommendation by the Resident's or Fellow's preceptor
- 3. 250 word essay by answering the following question: "Why is this appointment, as a Board Observer, important for you and what value does it contribute to your relationship with ACHE as a component of your career development?"
