### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Applicant is required to be 2017 paid dues Student Associate of ACHE and live in the ACHE southeast Texas area. However, during the selection process, preference will be given to applicants who have been Student Associates of ACHE for at least six months prior to applying.
- Applicant must be enrolled in his or her final year (fall/Spring) of <u>full-time</u> study in a recognized health administration graduate program (MHA, MBA, MPH) in southeast Texas and have a graduation date between Sept. 1, 2017, and Aug. 31, 2018. Students enrolled in either executive, doctoral programs, or on-line universities are not eligible.
- Currently enrolled in a HA program in which the university must be a member of ACHE's Higher Education Network (HEN) and the HA program is accredited by <u>either CAHME</u> or AACSB.
- Applicant must have a GPA of at least 3.5 prior to applying.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
- Applicant must be a U.S. or Canadian citizen.
- Applicant has participated in at least two **ACHE-SETC** sponsored events within the past year.
- Applicant <u>cannot be a previous recipient of any ACHE-SETC</u> scholarships (academic or ACHE Congress).

### **Completing the Application**

Please type or use black ink and print legibly when filling out the application. Provide a typewritten response to the case study that does **not exceed 5 pages**, not including title page and references. An appendix of no more than 2 pages will also be accepted. Please **submit your application** via email to **Kara Abrameit** along with a current resume, current transcript, and two letters of recommendation, one of which must be an academic reference, **no later than 5 p.m. on Friday, June 16, 2017**. No late applications will be accepted. Finalists will be asked to participate in a personal interview with members of the ACHE-SETC Awards and Recognition Board Committee the week of June 19<sup>th</sup> or June 26<sup>th</sup>.

It was written to test your critical thinking skills and reflect a part of your character. Any information that is being used from various reference materials to support your thinking must be cited correctly. Any form of cheating or plagiarism will disqualify a student's paper and this information forwarded to their Program Director.
