Dear Scholarship Applicant:

On behalf of the ACHE–SETC, we are pleased to inform you that, once again, our Chapter will award several scholarships to health administration (HA) graduate students to attend the 2022 ACHE Congress (March 28-30, 2022).

Eligibility for Submitting an Application

- <u>HA graduate student</u> who has been a <u>Student Associate of the ACHE national organization 60 days prior to</u> <u>December 31, 2021;</u>
- Maintains a residence in Southeast Texas;
- Pursuing a graduate degree in a recognized health administration program in the southeast Texas Region with a GPA of <u>at least 3.0</u>; (Online universities and Executive MHA or MBA programs <u>are not</u> eligible).
- Currently enrolled in a HA program in which the university must be a member of ACHE's Higher Education Network (HEN) and accredited by <u>either</u> CAHME or AACSB.
- Participated in at least three ACHE programs in the last year (volunteer or educational); <u>must list those programs on the application</u>.
- Has not been a recipient of an ACHE-SETC Congress Scholarship previously.

Completing the Application

Please type or use black ink and print legibly when filling out the application. Provide a typewritten essay (as instructed on the application) that does not exceed 1 page, not including title page and references. <u>Please submit your application via email to Mark Biscone (mbiscone@ache-houston.org</u>) along with a current resume and current transcript <u>no later than 5 p.m. (Central) Monday, January 31, 2022</u>. <u>No late applications will be accepted</u>. The recipients of the scholarship will be required to present a summary of their experience of Congress at a Chapter Board meeting (specific date to be determined) following the ACHE Congress event.
